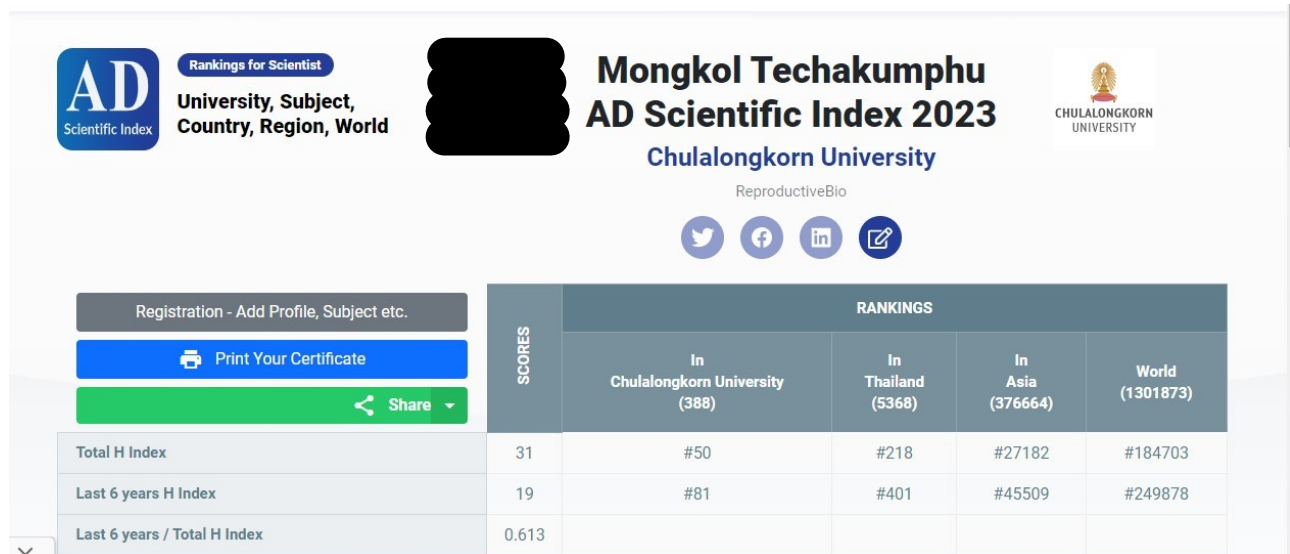


Curriculum vitae Prof Mongkol Thechakumphu



Biography

Professor Dr Mongkol Techakumphu, DVM, is a member of OGR Department, Faculty of Veterinary Science, Chulalongkorn University. He providing teaching and establishing several research centers, e.g. Reproductive biotechnology RU and OGR Biotech-Industrial Link Center. He has continuously developing research in biotechnology (sperm and embryo cryopreservation, IVP, ET, Stem cells) in farm animals, e.g. cows, buffaloes, goats, sheep, pigs and wildlife species. There is also development for further commercial use by creating a model for pig, goat and sheep business. He has published more than 300 peer review papers on Reproductive Biotechnology, Veterinary medicine, and Farm animal management, reproduction and medicine.
